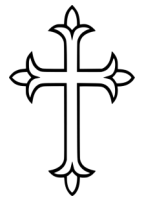

Dear Family,

Pastors Corner

Only the lover sings.

Said another way, "Singing belongs to one who loves." (St. Augustine)

Have you ever wondered why Holy Mother Church consider singing to be such an important element in our Liturgy? Have you ever wondered why I often will "attempt," however poor I am at it, to sing various parts of the Mass, such as the collect, prayer after communion, preface, dialogue (the Lord be with you...and with your spirit), and even on special occasions, the words of consecration (Institution narrative)? Allow me to share with you an excerpt from an article by a Fr. David Friel. He talks about this tradition in South Philly where the groom is expected to serenade his bride at some point before the wedding by singing to her from the street. He then draws a connection between this tradition and the necessity of singing at Mass:

"One who has experienced true love knows that there is a natural impulse that impels the lover to sing. We see it throughout the Song of Songs and in the prophet Isaiah: "Now let me sing of my friend, my beloved's song about his vineyard" (Isaiah 5:1). This impulse translates also into the sacred liturgy. If we believe that the liturgy is fundamentally a movement of love and an expression of our love for God, Who, Himself, is Love, then our liturgy should be sung!"

Doesn't this ring true in your heart? Love impels the heart to sing because words alone are insufficient. It wasn't until high school that I really began to do more than mouth the words to the songs at Mass or at best whisper them. I'd often open a hymnal and think to myself, I stink at singing and I don't like this song anyway, so why sing? What if others here me and I sound terrible? As one grows in love for Jesus, there wells up in the heart this desire to praise God in song. This weekend, you'll notice there are missalettes (hymnalls) back in the pews! Let's make sure they get some good use as we strive to become more and more a lover and less of a calculated, bashful bride.

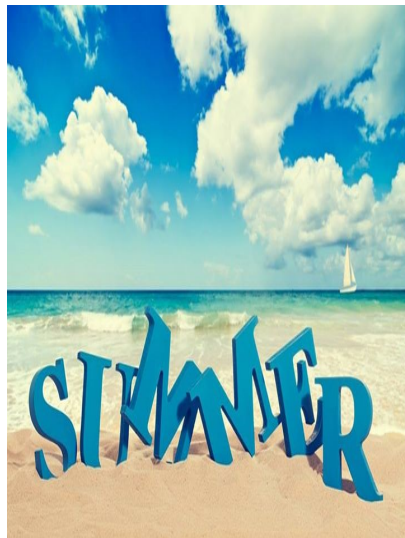
