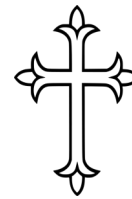

Pastors Corner

I have a couple of things I wanted to share with you this week and the first is that our very own Mary Alice Hutley is officially retiring in November this year. Mary Alice has been such a wonderful part of our parish staff for over two decades and she will be dearly missed from the work scene at Immaculate Conception. Until later, I won't even attempt to summarize the amazing impact she has had on our parish, but she has more than earned her retirement and I am so grateful for all the love and hard work she has poured into our parish for so many years. Please note that we have officially begun the hiring process and if you or someone you know is interested in applying for the position of part-time secretary for Immaculate Conception, you can apply by visiting our Immaculate Conception website.

Secondly, I am excited that we have officially resumed Perpetual Adoration at Immaculate Conception! Now that we have resumed, I have a couple of thoughts and requests regarding it. I am so thankful for everyone who volunteered to take an hour and I know God will bless you abundantly and help transform our parish more into the likeness of His Son, Jesus Christ, through this beautiful devotion.

Everyone (myself included) enjoys the intimacy of having 1 on 1 time with Our Lord, but I want to kindly remind everyone that we do not "own" Jesus, nor the hour we have agreed to cover, nor the chapel. Please do your best to be charitable and welcoming to anyone that drops by the chapel to pay a visit to Our Lord, even and especially if it is not their assigned hour and even if it is a little distracting or annoying. I want everyone who comes to our adoration chapel to feel welcomed. Of course, if you don't feel safe opening the door for someone you don't know and if it's at night, I want you to be cautious and use your best judgment as to whether to allow visitors in. On the whole though, during the day, please be generous and gracious to those who may visit Our Lord during your hour.

Finally, I wanted to highlight the integral connection between the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and Adoration of the Eucharist. As Pope emeritus Benedict XVI put it, "The act of adoration outside Mass prolongs and finds nourishment in the reception of Holy Communion. The priority is always to attend Mass, which is the highest form of worship and there must never be an attitude of "you like going to Mass, but I make adoration my priority" since this is completely wrong-minded. I want to make sure that Perpetual adoration in our chapel doesn't become seen as disconnected from what happens in the Church, particular the daily Sacrifice of the Mass. This is the reason I will be reposing the Blessed Sacrament before each Mass in the church and giving all adorers the opportunity (which I highly encourage) to participate in the Mass and to receive Holy Communion. This intensifies all that takes place during the liturgical celebration itself." There is no competition between Mass and Adoration, between receiving/eating the Bread of Life and adoring Him. Adoration naturally flows from and finds its origin in the Mass, where we encounter Christ's saving work on the Cross, which is made present to us through Holy Communion.

May God bless the good work we have begun and may it bear much fruit in our lives!
