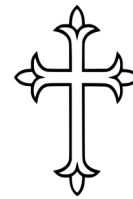


Immaculate Conception Parish Saint Stanislaus Parish

Pastor's Corner

Dear Family,

I humbly ask for your prayers for the conversion of all the souls I am responsible for, which includes every person in St. Marys, Rossville, Delia, and Emmett and the surrounding area. Lately, I have felt a heaviness and sadness at the indifference of so many toward Jesus, His infinite love, and their eternal salvation. So many are ignorant of the truths of Our Faith and it weighs on me that they do not really know Christ personally nor do they seek Him but are content to chase after the passing things of this life. Our Lord spoke intimately to St. Faustina Kowalska about this lack of conversion of souls and specifically asked her (and us) to pray for their conversion. We are failing in our duty to evangelize if we are not actively praying for our family, friends, and neighbors who do not practice The Faith.

This is something that St. Faustina heard in prayer and wrote down in her diary and it strikes me as being very timely for us to take to heart:

*Today Jesus said to me, "I desire that you know more profoundly the love that burns in My Heart for souls, and you will understand this when you meditate upon My Passion. Call upon My mercy on behalf of sinners; I desire their salvation. When you say this prayer, with a contrite heart and with faith on behalf of some sinner, I will give him the grace of conversion. This is the prayer: **O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of Mercy for us, I trust in You.**"*

My dear brothers and sisters, please say this prayer with me each day and even several times a day. Say it with devotion and trust. Say it for someone in particular that Our Lord has placed in your path and that you know is in need of deeper conversion.

May God touch the most hardened hearts of His sheep, giving them a sincere sorrow for their sins and a deep encounter with his merciful love.
