Pastor's Corner

Preparing for our Journey into Lent

Do you even lift, bro?

This question, used to razz someone for not being as strong as they should be, has become a popular internet meme. While sometimes not used in good taste, it is often thrown out there among friends as a friendly tease toward someone who might be posturing, pretending to be stronger than they really are or even someone who just needs to be challenged to be better.

I want to use it as our slogan for this year's Lenten journey. This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of our Lenten exodus into the desert. What are we supposed to be doing in the desert for the next 40 days? Lifting weights! There are some exercises that are essential to growth in the gym, such as the deadlift, squat, and bench press. Similarly, Jesus offers us three of the most fundamental spiritual exercises we need to engage in this Lent if we want to grow in holiness. What are they? **Prayer. Fasting. Almsgiving.**

I may regret this, but I'm encouraging you to ask yourself, your family, and your close friends (on a daily basis)

"Do you even lift, bro?", as a way to hold yourself and others accountable to the spiritual discipline of Lent that is so conducive to spiritual growth.

A word of caution: Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving aren't about becoming strong on our own will power, nor is Lent a self-help program. Rather, by engaging in prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we strip away our attachment to noise, pleasure, and entertainment and make room for Jesus in our lives <u>so that He can transform us</u> from mediocre hypocrites to saints on fire with love for God and neighbor. Some ideas for your three spiritual exercises:

Prayer: Make a daily visit to the Blessed Sacrament for 10 minutes; Bible in a year with Fr. Mike Schmitz; dailyrosary.net (pray the rosary each day with Dr. Mike Scherschligt); Stations of the Cross (communally on Fridays or privately); Read a saint story each day (40 saints); Read the Gospel reading for Mass each day and meditate on it for 5 minutes.

Fasting: What are you too attached to? What do you regularly indulge in? Sacrifice it! Food, drink, social media, gaming, eating out, etc. Perhaps instead of completely sacrificing an item, consider getting a version of it that you like less (i.e. an off-brand coffee). Please do not skip!

Almsgiving: Take the money you save from fasting and put it in a jar to give to a charitable organization. Think spiritual and corporal works of mercy—pick one of these to focus on. Visit the elderly at a nursing home once a week. Each week, write a note of affirmation to someone special in your life. Sit with someone you don't know at a fish fry. Donate food to the food bank.

May God bless you this coming Lent with the grace to be transformed into the image of Jesus Christ. Let's get started off on the right foot!

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured. If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the <u>Victim</u> <u>Care Advocate</u> at (913) 298-9244
