Pastor's Corner

# The Liturgy of the Hours

When we talk about **The Liturgy**, we are talking about the perfect praise and worship given to God the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit; an eternal symphony of love in the Trinity. When we go to Mass, we enter into this perfect, eternal exchange of love. This is so much more than a lecture or a Bible study. Liturgy is public worship, the official worship of the Body of Christ, The Church. By virtue of our participation in Christ's work as members of the Body, we also participate in the divine life of the Trinity, an eternal exchange of love between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. As with any sacrament, the action or "doing" is all God's, but we are invited to join in it, both as the worship for which we are made and for the sanctification of the world. Worship can be both public (liturgy) and private (devotional, both individual and communal). Examples of private worship would be the rosary, novenas, or the Divine Mercy chaplet. While private worship is incredibly important, it is always second in importance to the public worship of the Church.

Did you know that there is another form of liturgical prayer that is only second in importance to The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and one which The Church desires all of us to pray?

The Liturgy of the Hours, sometimes known as the "Divine Office" or the "Breviary," is the form of liturgical prayer that complements the Mass, flows from it, and "echoes" it throughout our day. The Liturgy of the Hours has two chief offices of Morning Prayer (Lauds) and Evening Prayer (Vespers), as well as five other offices of prayer set for other intervals during the day. These daily offices revolve around the praying of the psalms and canticles from the Bible, and include the Our Father, Scripture readings, the reflections of the saints, intercessions, hymns and other various prayers. The Liturgy of the Hours unites us in prayer with every other Catholic in the world and sanctifies "the hours" of our day.

"By tradition going back to early Christian times, the Divine Office is devised so that the whole course of the day and night is made holy by the praises of God. Therefore, when this wonderful song of praise is rightly performed by priests and others who are deputed for this purpose by the Church's ordinance, or by the faithful praying together with the priest in the approved form, then it is truly the voice of the bride addressed to her bridegroom; It is the very prayer which Christ Himself, together with His body, addresses to the Father" (Sacrosanctum Concilium 84).

"Pastors of souls should see to it that the chief hours, especially Vespers, are celebrated in common in church on Sundays and the more solemn feasts" (SC 100).

As a way to help keep Sunday Holy and to introduce you to the Liturgy of the Hours, we will have a holy hour of adoration before the Blessed Sacrament on Sunday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 3pm, at St. Stanislaus. It will include praise and worship music, Benediction, and Vespers (Evening Prayer). Don't worry, I will give a short explanation of how to pray Vespers and we will provide the materials.

# REPORTING SUSPECTED ABUSE

If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330.

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the Victim Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244 \*AFTER\* calling local law enforcement.
