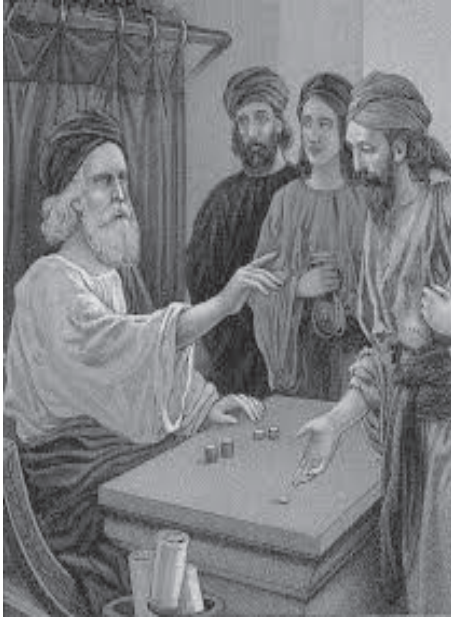

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard.' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' When those who had started about five o'clock came, each received the usual daily wage. So when the first came, they thought that they would receive more, but each of them also got the usual wage. And on receiving it they grumbled against the landowner, saying, 'These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat.' He said to one of them in reply, 'My friend, I am not cheating you. Did you not agree with me for the usual daily wage? Take what is yours and go. What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last."

Pastor's Corner

On Thursday, Sept 24th at Immaculate Conception Church, we will have a special opportunity to host what is called the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima! This world-famous statue of our Blessed Mother Mary was sculpted in 1947 by famous sculptor José Thedim. The image reflects the precise instructions of Sister Lucia, who was one of three children in Fatima, Portugal in 1917 that Our Blessed Mother appeared to. Mary promised that God would grant peace to the entire world if Her requests for prayer, reparation and consecration were heard and obeyed. This Thursday, I would invite you to make a little time to pray before this famous statue which has visited over 100 countries and which Mother Mary has used to convey her presence and her love to so many people. Of course, the statue itself conveys no magical power, but Our Lady has used this statue to bestow many graces and favors upon the people that venerate this image of her. Many miracles, especially spiritual miracles, have been reported, such as the conversion of hardened hearts. This statue was also reported to have wept tears in New Orleans in 1972 as well and on numerous other occasions. As your pastor, my hope and prayer in hosting this famous traveling statue is that you will be drawn to a deeper love for Our Lady and that the time you take to gaze upon this statue of our Mother as you pray will bring peace into your lives and your homes. Please pray for peace, for the conversion of hearts to Jesus, in reparation for our sins, and for the strengthening and protection of our families.

We will host the statue from 3pm-8pm on Sept. 24th at Immaculate Conception. The Schedule: 3pm - Procession of the statue and Divine Mercy Chaplet; 3:30 - Patrick Sabat, the principle statue custodian, will give a brief presentation; 4:00 - Holy Rosary; 4-6:30 - Personal quiet time for prayer before the statue. Confessions heard from 5-6pm; 6:30pm - Mass; 7-8pm - Personal quiet time for prayer before the statue.

**Project Andrew Event for Young Men in High School:
 An Invitation from Jesus Christ to "Follow Me"**

Jesus Christ is calling you to follow Him. It's a fact. The question which remains is – What does that look like for you? What is it about a relationship with Jesus Christ that has the power to transform a boy into a man - a man who is willing to lay down his life for his friends – as a spiritual father and priest? Join Archbishop Joseph Naumann, Vocation Director Fr. Dan Morris, seminarian George Rhodes, and area priests as together we unpack those two simple but life-giving words of Jesus: "Follow me" (Matthew 4:19).

Project Andrew will include a witness talk from an area high school senior, and how he has gone about discerning his vocation these past 4 years. Next you will hear from a seminarian, and how his time in seminary has helped form him into the man God is calling him to be. Third, you will hear insights and highlights from a day in the life of one of our newly ordained priests. Last but not least, our own shepherd and successor of the Apostles, Archbishop Naumann, will share his wisdom while leading us in a time of Eucharistic Adoration. Parents are welcome and strongly encouraged to attend, as the parents of one of our seminarians will speak about this calling, and what it has been like to journey with their son from their perspective.

New to Project Andrew this year, is an invitation to journey with the Vocation Director and area priests – just like Andrew, Simon, James and John did with Jesus. They didn't settle for one encounter with Christ, and you shouldn't either. This high school group will meet regularly at Good Shepherd Parish in Shawnee. There will be formation, prayer, conversation, brotherhood, and developing virtue using books and videos like The Chosen, and Into the Breach. The goal is to grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ in a way that will prepare you to say "Yes" to the vocation God calls you to, whatever that may be.

Project Andrew is October 4 at St. Joseph in Topeka. Come and see how your next few years can be more fulfilling, rather than risking being lost in the culture and temptations of the day.
