Jesus said to the chief priests and the elders of the people: "Hear another parable. There was a landowner who planted a vineyard, put a hedge around it, dug a wine press in it, and built a tower. Dear Family,

Elections. Politics. Conscience. Truth. Values. It's that time of year again when our blood pressure spikes and our tempers flare as we attempt to navigate the complex privilege we have as Catholics to be involved in political life, to vote, and to build up a culture of life in our country. No matter how much we would prefer to avoid politics all together, **it is our Catholic duty to know the issues, to know the candidates, and to vote with a well-formed conscience based on core Catholic principles.** We often hear that we should vote according to our conscience, but that doesn't mean voting according to personal feelings or based on a few catch sound-bytes that tickle our ears. Sadly, there is no magical manual that gives us the answers and tells us exactly who to vote for. We are called not to vote according to party lines, but according to values and principles and the Church helps guide us by providing a hierarchy of values. Forming your conscience takes work!
