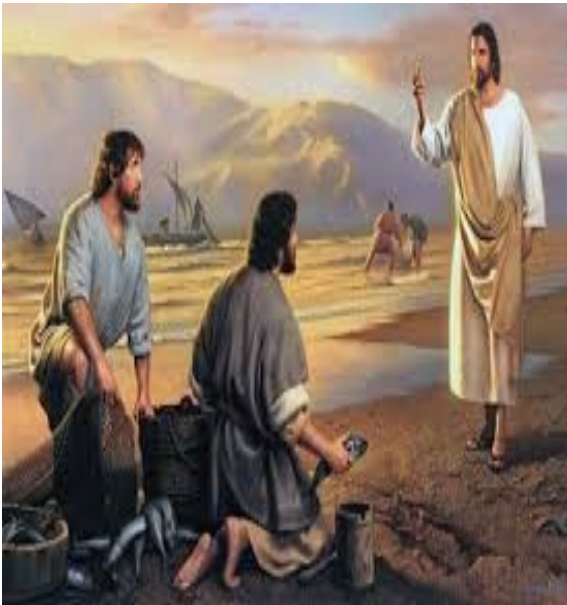
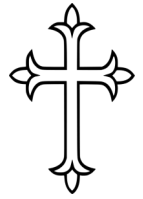


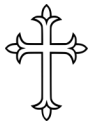

Pastor's Corner



Dear Family,

Just last week, On October 10th, the Catholic Church beatified the first millennial ever! This millennial and computer whiz's name is Carlo Acutis and it is being said that he is the first 'Blessed' who played the video game "Halo" with his friends and who loved Super Mario and Pokémon, but not as much as he

loved the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist." He died at the age of 15 of Leukemia in 2006 and is already being recognized as the patron of the internet because of his gift for computer programming. Carlo created a website to catalog Eucharistic miracles and saw the internet as a way to bring people closer to Jesus. Cardinal Agostino Vallini said in his homily for the beatification:

"He was an ordinary boy, simple, spontaneous, likeable ... he loved nature and animals, he played football, he had many friends of his age, he was attracted by modern means of social communication, passionate about computer science and, self-taught, he built websites to transmit the Gospel, to communicate values and beauty." Here are my [top 5 favorite quotes](#) from Blessed Carlo Acutis:

1. "Sadness is looking at ourselves, happiness is looking towards God."
2. "Not me, but God."
3. "The only thing we have to ask God for, in prayer, is the desire to be holy."
4. "Our soul is like a hot air balloon. If by chance there is a mortal sin, the soul falls to the ground. Confession is like the fire underneath the balloon enabling the soul to rise again. . . It is important to go to confession often."
5. "The Eucharist is the highway to heaven."

AHRS Subcontractors' Bidder Update—October 6, 2020.

Kent Francis, CBC member, visited AHRS office in Bern, KS to view the various bid packages received. Several bids were received for the various construction packages. (i.e. Excavation, Demolition, Utilities, Concrete, Masonry, Steel, Drywall, Carpentry, Finishes, Specialties, Plumbing, HVAC and Electrical.

After receipt the bids require AHRS to review for content and compliance prior to final reporting. However the general appearance was/is many of the bids were less than the budgeted amount.

AHRS will provide a complete analysis within the near future and submit their recommendation to the CBC. If acceptable a contract for construction will need to be prepared by Sabatini Architects for review and signature by the Archdiocese. Construction should begin within the next 30 days.
