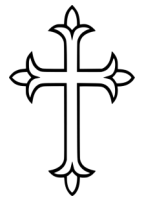


Immaculate Conception Parish Saint Stanislaus Parish

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.

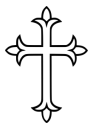
Blessed are the clean of heart, for they will see God.

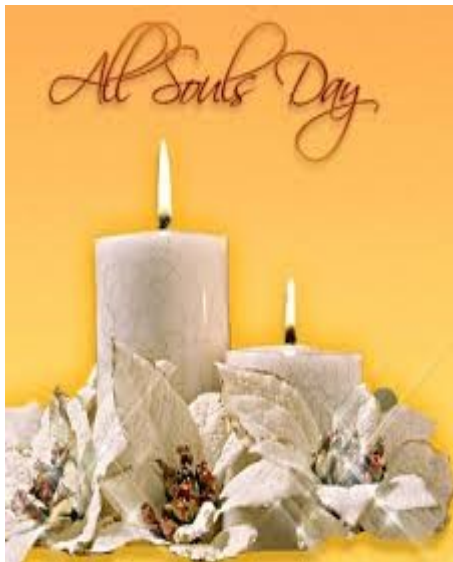

Pastor's Corner

Dear Family,

I spoke this past weekend briefly about our Holy Father's comments regarding civil unions for same-sex couples. Here is a great recap of the discussion, which I am quoting from Archbishop Naumann's Leaven Column:

"The documentary, Francesco, chronicling the ministry of Pope Francis and his solicitude for the poor, the refugee, the sick and all those on the margins of society, created quite a media firestorm. The media has focused upon a segment of the film where the Pope is evidently responding to a question about the pastoral care for those with same-sex attraction. Pope Francis encouraged parents to love children and family members who struggle with same-sex attraction. He reminded viewers how important familial bonds are for all of us. The Holy Father expressed support for civil unions for homosexuals, specifically in order that individuals have access to health care and inheritance privileges. The Holy Father did not endorse same-sex marriage in the documentary, but once again offered the notion of civil unions as a means to avoid state sanctioning of homosexual marriage. Pope Francis did not question or dispute the gravely sinful nature of homosexual actions. Moreover, no Pope has the authority to change a moral teaching that is both rooted in the Bible, 2,000-year old tradition and the consistent moral teaching of the Church. Similarly, no Pope has the ability to change the nature of marriage nor the Church's understanding of matrimony that is rooted in the Bible, Church tradition and natural law. Pope Francis' apparent affirmation of civil unions differs from the opinion expressed less than 20 years ago by the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith that counseled against homosexual civil unions because of the confusion of equating them with marriage. Unfortunately, Our Holy Father's statements about the possibility of civil unions for homosexuals has been construed to mean that the Church wants to sanction same-sex marriages, which is not only blatantly incorrect and a complete misunderstanding of what he said, but truly impossible for the Church to ever teach. Same sex unions and same sex marriages are not the same thing. Let us take this situation as an opportunity pray for all those who struggle to live a life of chastity."

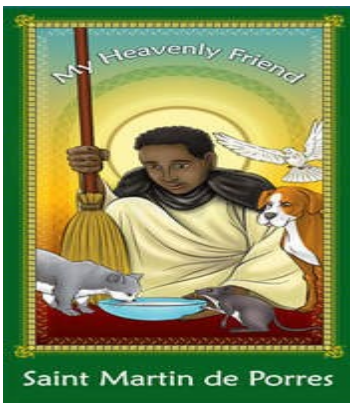
