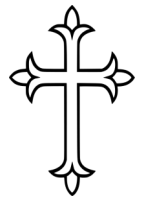
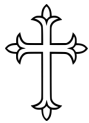

Pastor's Corner

I hope you had a wonderful Christmas and New Year!

This week I wanted to feature a friend who is a stay-at-home mom and a blogger. Her name is Elizabeth Bundy. Not only is she a prayerful and faithful Catholic, but she has a knack for taking day-to-day events in the life of a mother and wife and finding God's little whispers in them. Here is one of her most recent posts about prayer. FYI Theresa is her little daughter:

"There are some days that Theresa will say to me "Mommy, let's dance!" while listening to some music, but there tends to be more days that she wants to dance with no music. It is so easy to jump into dancing with some music, but sometimes I find it more challenging when nothing is playing. Sure, I could put some music on or sing something, but in that split second moment she wants to dance with me and not figure out music. So, I put myself into it and try moving to a made up rhythm and beat. These moments I have found are more important and beautiful than the ones that we have the music and prepared to dance together.

Sometimes our prayer life can feel like dancing with the music with the perfect melody in the background. It is easy to jump into it and it comes naturally. We are able to feel something and are enjoying the experience with God. But, I think there are times that we are being asked to pray and it is like radio silence. We are trying to move and feel a bit silly because we aren't in the groove or don't know how to move or where to move. These opportunities where we try to put ourselves into that moment of prayer - even if we just aren't into it, we are feeling clunky or foolish, or just can't seem to hear anything are more important than those moments that come easy. God sees these moments and delights in them - just like a parent delighting in their child dancing around the house with him/her without a note of music."
