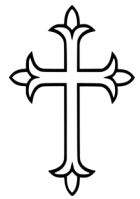


Immaculate Conception Parish Saint Stanislaus Parish

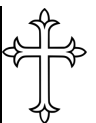

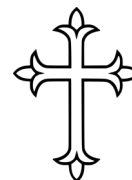
