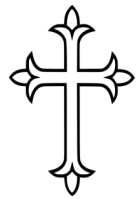

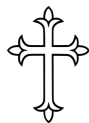

Pastor's Corner

Dear Family

Following up on my homily from last weekend, here is the prayer I promised to share with you:

"In the name, power, blood, and authority of Jesus Christ, I bind and rebuke all unclean spirits that may be afflicting me. I renounce the sins of _____ and I renounce any affection I have retained for them. I reject the empty promises of Satan, I refuse to be mastered by sin, and I hereby offer to God every disordered attachment and every wound that keeps me from Him. Amen."

While this prayer is oriented toward naming and renouncing sin and our hidden affection for it, it is also a great prayer for naming and renouncing any lies that we have been living our life by, perhaps with our realizing it. As we heard in the Gospel last Sunday, Jesus has the power to heal each of us – believe it! – but first remember that we must approach Him and ask to be healed.

I also wanted to remind every that this Sunday (6th Sunday in Ordinary Time) is World Marriage Day. We pray for a strengthening of all married couples in our parish and that God would open the hearts of all couples to receive the grace of the Sacrament of Marriage more fully. We also pray that all powers and forces which are undermining marriage and attempting to redefine it and destroy it will be stopped. Please join our parish in praying this prayer for all of the married couples in our parish and families:

Almighty and eternal God, you blessed the union of married couples so that they might reflect the union of Christ with his Church: look with kindness on them. Renew their marriage covenant, increase your love in them, and strengthen their bond of peace so that with their children, they may always rejoice in the gift of your blessing. We ask this through Christ our Lord.
