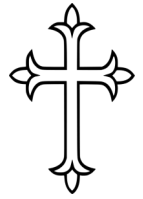

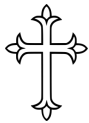

Dear Family,

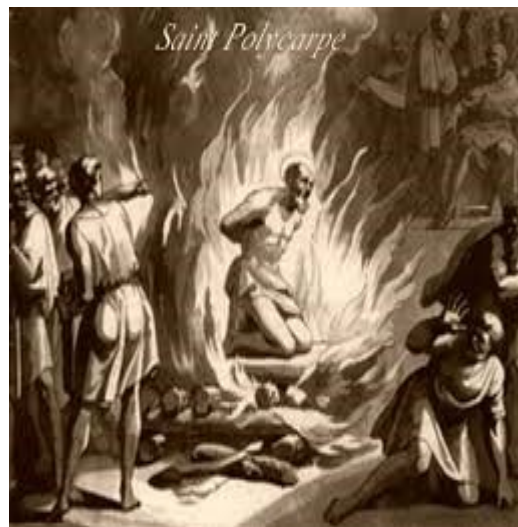
Topeka IrishFest 2021 Lite
