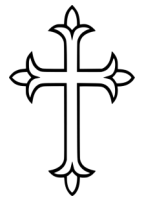

Pastor's Corner

Vocation.

Being Called....by name.



This word used to scare the living daylight out of me, mainly when I was in high school. Mom and Dad would talk to us kids about vocations from time to time, about how God wanted us to serve him in unique way in our lives. I imagined the "I want you" Uncle Sam poster when I heard the word "vocations." I don't know why I felt so intimidated by this idea of being chosen, of being called, other than that I feared failing. What if God asks me to serve him in a way that stretches me, in a way that reveals my poverty, in a way that takes me out into the deep waters, away from the shore and my comfort zone which it represents? What if I discover my own inadequacies, my unworthiness or even worse, what if others discover how weak I am? Ironically, I had good reason to believe that God tends to pick the things that stretch us, that teach us to rely on him because we simply can't control things. Think of COVID-19 and the year 2020 for that matter! Fear is often the biggest obstacle for young people as it was for me in discerning my vocation. Putting fear aside, it is so important to ask the following questions if you do not yet know your vocation in life: Why did God make me? How does he want me to serve him? Have I ever considered that he might be calling me to become a priest or

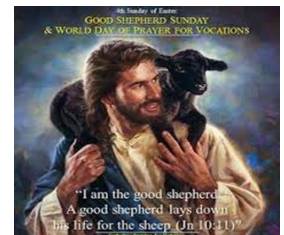
religious brother or sister? What is my vocation? Not, do I have a vocation, but what is it? Every person is called personally, uniquely and tenderly by our Lord as we hear in in John 10:27:

"My Sheep **hear my voice**, and I know them, and they **follow me.**"

Jesus is calling you. Do you seek to hear him and do you desire to follow him, even if he calls you out into the deep? Do not be afraid! Ask Jesus to reveal your vocation to you. If you are a young person discerning your vocation, St. Stanislaus, St. Aloysius Gonzaga, St. Tarcisius, and St. Therese of Lisieux are excellent saints to pray to.

This week, please pray that young men and women hear and respond generously to the Lord's call to the priesthood, diaconate and religious life.

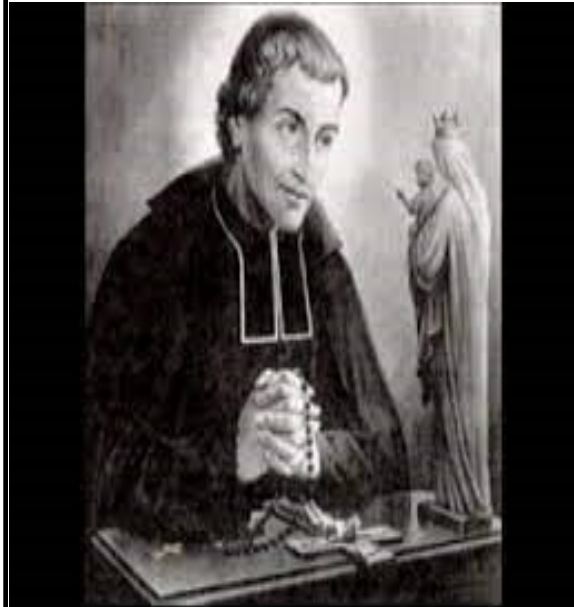
