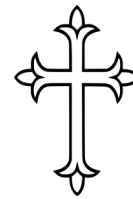

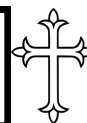

Pastor's Corner

As I emphasized with our Confirmation students, we Christians are in a spiritual battle with the devil. You may have heard of the term "spiritual warfare," which is used to describe times in one's life when it appears that one is experiencing quite a few troubles and difficulties that go beyond just the normal inconveniences we experience in our daily life and that feel like targeted attacks. Much of the suffering, pain and wickedness of what we call principalities, against powers against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual host of wickedness of the heavenly places." (Ephesians 6:12). The visible world is influenced and fueled by the dark forces of the invisible world. "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but Now, this is not to say that every time our car breaks down, we get a nasty phone call from someone, or we break our leg that the devil is specifically targeting us. However, Scripture tells us that "the dragon became angry with the woman and went off to wage war against the rest of her offspring, those who keep God's commandments and bear witness to Jesus" (Revelation 12:17). Satan is a sworn enemy of God and His people and we are warned in 1 Peter 5:8 to be on guard: "Be sober and vigilant. Your opponent the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion looking for [someone] to devour." When we are trying to love God, to follow His will, and to grow in our friendship with Christ, we can expect that Satan won't be pleased and will in some way seek to discourage us. Resist these attacks and ask for prayer from your friends when you detect this "spiritual warfare." The St. Michael the Archangel prayer is a very effective prayer to pray in this regard.

I would humbly ask for your prayers. Archbishop Naumann said something in a homily to the effect that "priests have a target painted on them." I would be a fool not to ask you to include me in your intentions and prayers each day, especially in your family prayers. I need your prayers and support to be a holy priest and a good father. Thank you to those of you who already pray for me each day. Let's pray for one another and ask for each other's prayers.
