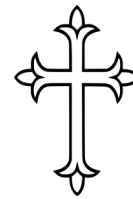


Immaculate Conception Parish Saint Stanislaus Parish



On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples said to him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?" He sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water. Follow him. Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, "The Teacher says, "Where is my guest room where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?" Then he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready. Make the preparations for us there." The disciples then went off, entered the city, and found it just as he had told; and they prepared the Passover.

While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it, this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Amen, I say to you, I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." Then, after singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

Last week for the Solemnity of the Most Blessed Trinity I quoted some paragraphs from the Catechism of the Catholic Church and I want to continue sharing relevant passages from it throughout the year because it is such a little known treasure. Imagine having all our Catholic beliefs neatly, beautifully and richly summed up in one book. Well you have no need to only imagine it because in 1992 this Catechism was promulgated by Pope John Paul II and after the Bible is probably the most useful resource for us Catholics to better understand and explain our faith! Do you have a copy of it (they are quite inexpensive)? Have you read it? Please consider purchasing a copy and reading a little bit each day!

What does the Church teach about the Eucharist?

"The Catholic Church teaches that in the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of the God-man are really, truly, substantially, and abidingly present together with his soul and divinity by reason of the Transubstantiation of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. This takes place in the unbloody sacrifice of the Mass."

Sadly, a majority of Catholics don't believe in the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist and only believe it is a symbol. The Catechism has this to say about the Real Presence:

1374 *The mode of Christ's presence under the Eucharistic species is unique. It raises the Eucharist above all the sacraments as "the perfection of the spiritual life and the end to which all the sacraments tend."* ²⁰¹ *In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist "the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained."* ²⁰² *"This presence is called 'real' - by which is not intended to exclude the other types of presence as if they could not be 'real' too, but because it is presence in the fullest sense: that is to say, it is a substantial presence by which Christ, God and man, makes himself wholly and entirely present."* ²⁰³

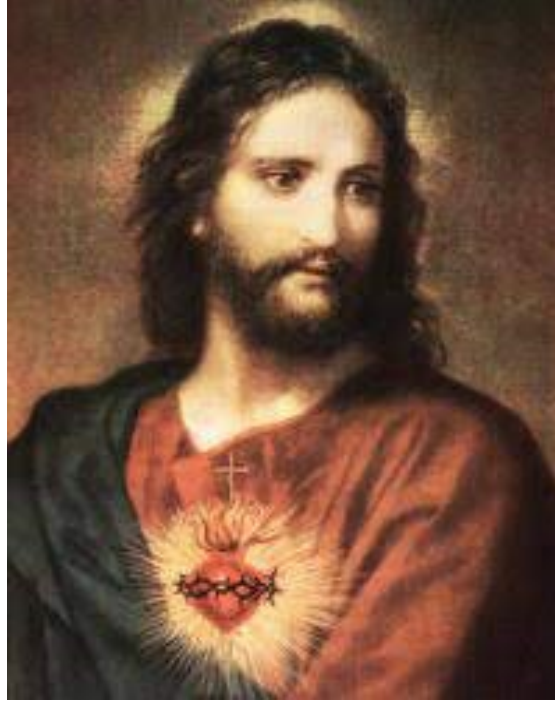
