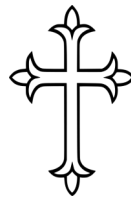


Immaculate Conception Parish Saint Stanislaus Parish

At that they were utterly astounded. He gave strict orders that no one should know this and said that she should be given something to eat.

I wanted to give a big shoutout to all of our teens and chaperones that were a part of what is called "Prayer and Action." Prayer and Action (Panda) is a service retreat ministry that provides our teens the unique opportunity to grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church while serving the local communities of north-east Kansas. They spent most of last week on this retreat, which was based at Most Pure Heart of Mary in Topeka, bearing the heat of the day so that they could paint, clean, fix, and help restore people's homes and yards for free, often people who were struggling to keep up or were unable to do some of these tasks for various reasons. They also got to know the people that they were serving, to spend time with them, to love them, and to show them the face of Christ while also encountering His face in those people they served. They had to put up with some level of discomfort (who is willing to sleep on the floor, sometimes without AC?!), but it was part of a beautiful sacrifice to the people they served. In the evenings and mornings, they had spiritual talks, prayer time, fellowship, sharing, and opportunities to encounter Christ through the Sacraments. What I especially love is that a St. Stanislaus and an Immaculate Conception crew were able to go the same week, to work side by side with each other, and to grow in friendship and faith together! I think they all really enjoyed it and grew a lot from it. Here is a picture of both parishes' crew – what a proud moment for this father!
