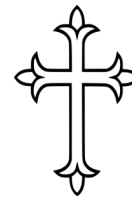

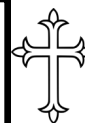

 Intentional.

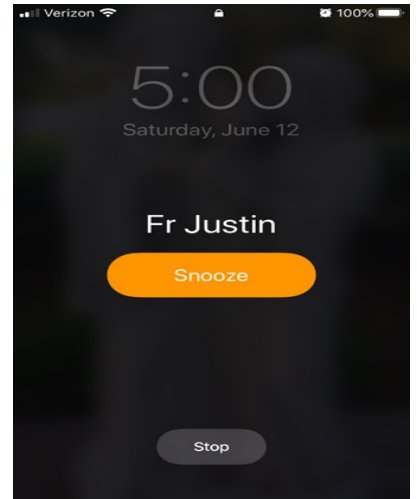
This is perhaps the most important adjective in relation to prayer. Intentional prayer. How easy it is, especially during the summer and during Ordinary Time, to pray sporadically and without any deliberate plan. For example, I might pray when my child is feeling sick or I might pray when my crops are in desperate need of some rain and this prayer is good, but it isn't necessarily intentional and it won't be consistent. Here is what I think of when I think about prayer that is characterized by commitment, intentionality, and a deliberate assent of the will toward the good. I have a friend who intentionally prays for me at 5pm every day by setting a reminder on her phone (hopefully she doesn't push the snooze button!).

There have been times in my life where I have set a reminder on my phone so that I don't forget or become too busy for daily prayer, which is so essential for our spiritual growth. I would compare it to the daily workouts that a marathon runner incorporates into his training routine. Imagine if he only ran marathons and didn't do any sort of training in between! Sadly, we sometimes make the mistake of not taking the time for intentional, quiet prayer each day in between our Sunday Masses and thinking that our "Sunday marathon" will be sufficient, but it isn't.

So, here is your thought for the week:

Do I need to set a reminder on my phone, calendar, bathroom mirror etc. to become more intentional about a daily time of prayer with God?
