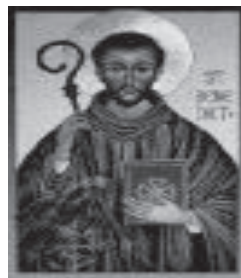
Marriage Minute
