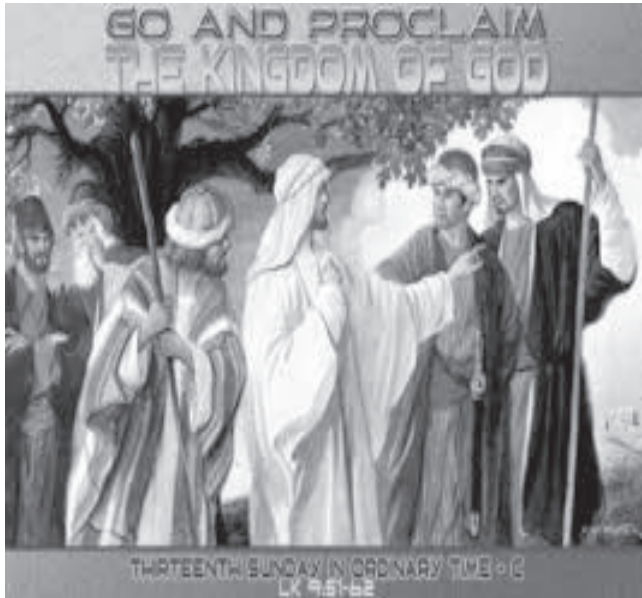

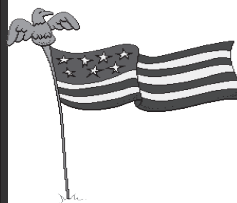

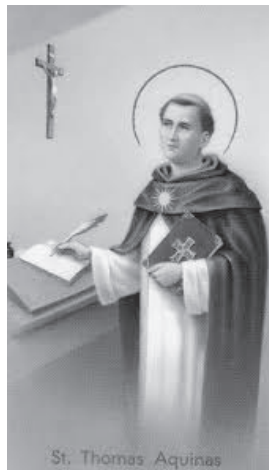
FIT Teams Organize Church Picnic:
