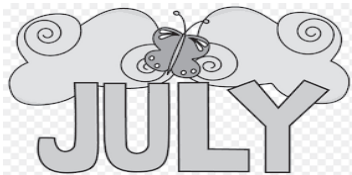

Anyone wanting to dispose of old palms, please drop off at office or leave in back of church. They will be burned and used for Ash Wednesday ashes for next year.



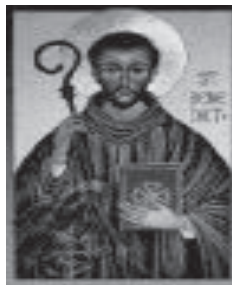
Pilgrimage to the Holy Land With Fr. Ray~
