

Pastor's Corner

Dare to be Great (Like the Saints)

I am excited to announce the completion of our relic project at Immaculate Conception! While some of this pastor's corner primarily applies to Immaculate Conception parishioners, I want both of our parishes to be aware of this project. On several occasions, such as on feast days and All Saints Day, I have displayed some of the relics of the saints that we have. You may recall that a relic is a fragment of the body or the physical possession of a canonized saint. A first class relic is a body part of a saint, such as bone, blood, or flesh. Second class relics are possessions that a saint owned. Almost all the relics we have are first class relics. The reason I started this project is because I want all of us to develop a greater friendship with the saints, to know their stories and to draw inspiration from their virtuous lives. Inspiration is a powerful motivator. Just ask anyone with a poster of a famous musician or athlete hanging in their room. The project involved four elements:

- 1. Verify/authenticate each relic to make sure it is genuine. This was done with the help of an expert who personally examined and repaired the relics.
- 2. Obtain fitting reliquaries (gold containers for the relics).
- 3. Create a dignified and secure case for each relic so that we can display them throughout the year for veneration. A huge shout out and "thank you" to our very own parishioners, Trevor Carlson and Keith Aubert, for creating these wooden display cases. Trevor worked under the expert guidance of Keith to make them and it's exciting to have another home-grown project we can take great pride in!



4. Mount the cases on the walls (thank you Jason Henderson and Malcolm Smith for doing this!) and offer holy cards and biographical inspiration about each saint that people can take home to help them grow in devotion to the saint. Please help yourself to the resources in the windowsills.

We intentionally installed the relics on the walls of the nave (next to the pews) as a fitting reminder that the saints accompany us through life. Find the relic nearest your pew as you walk in and remember that the saints (and angels) are worshiping God with you at each Mass (scooch over St. Anthony of Padua, you're taking up too much room in the pew!)

May God be glorified through this project and may it lead to our sanctification.

REPORTING SUSPECTED ABUSE

If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330. Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured. If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the <u>Victim</u> Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244

AFTER calling local law enforcement.
