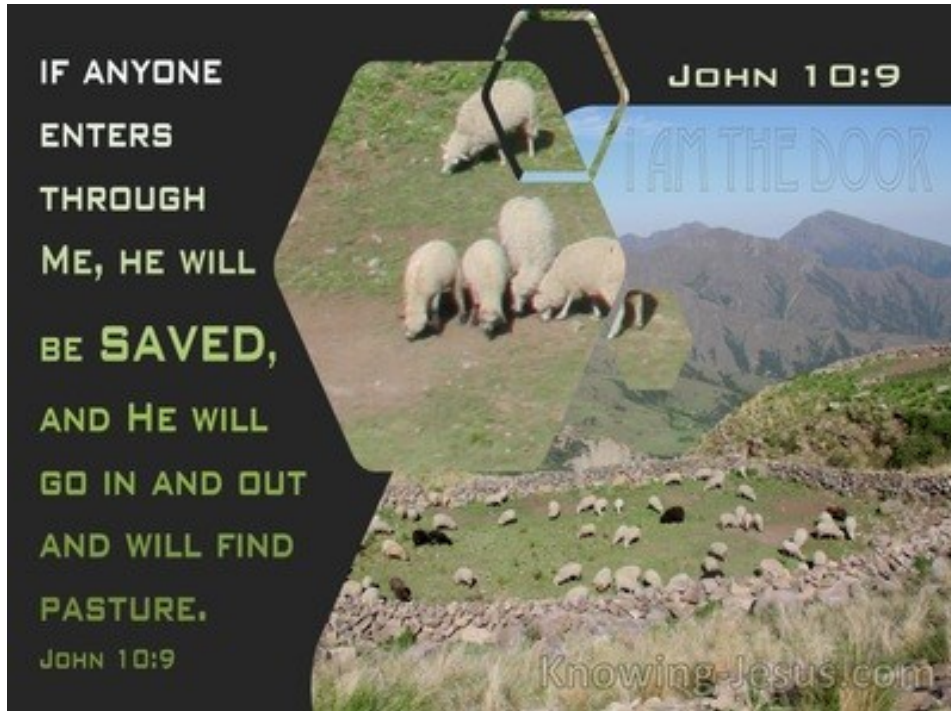
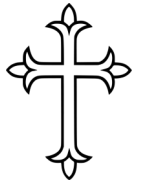

In the months ahead, Catholic Charities' Topeka Family Support Center will transition from 234 S. Kansas Avenue to the current home of Let's Help Inc. at 245 SW MacVicar Avenue. Services at Let's Help will continue without interruption. More importantly, with Catholic Charities assuming responsibilities for operations and future development, this space will allow life-changing programs to grow including food assistance, housing support, education and employment services.

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244*
