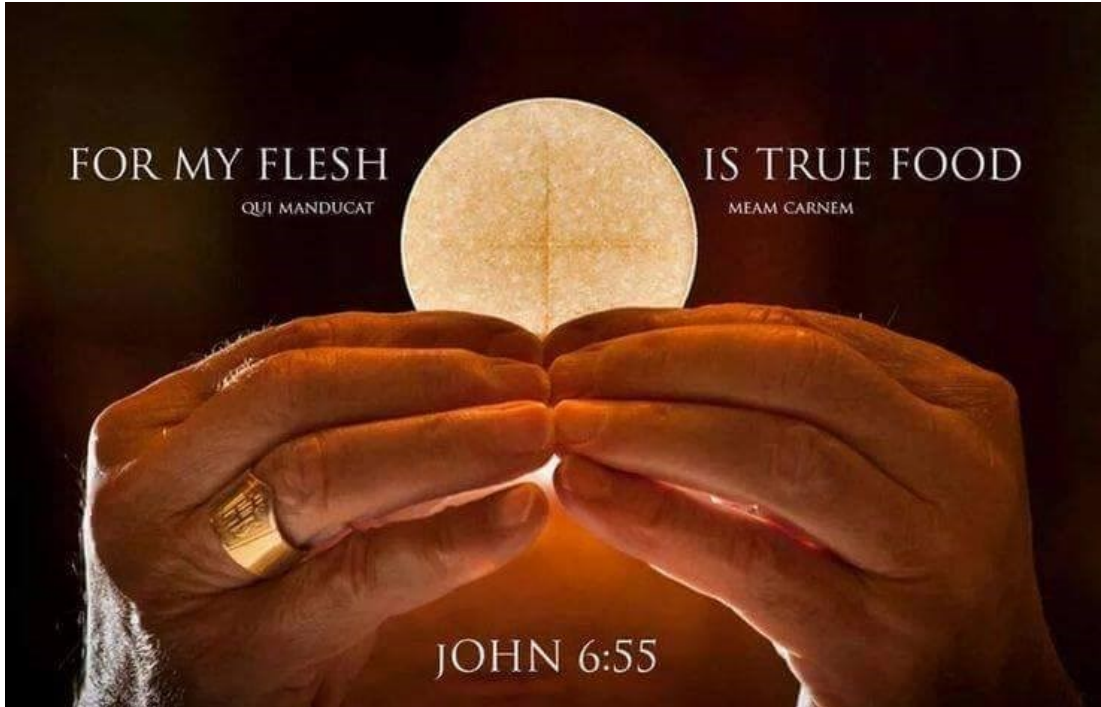
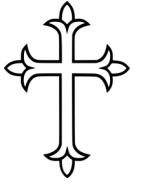

Quotes

-“... take care to lose no part of It [the Body of the Lord]. Such a loss would be the mutilation of your own body. Why, if you had been given gold-dust, would you not take the utmost care to hold it fast, not letting a grain slip through your fingers, lest you be so much the poorer? How much more carefully, then, will you guard against losing so much as a crumb of that which is more precious than gold or precious stones?”
St. Cyril of Jerusalem, Mystagogical Catecheses, 5, 2

-Pope Pius XI ordered that the following stringent exhortation be published:

“In the administration of the Eucharistic Sacrament, one must demonstrate a particular zeal, so that no fragments of the consecrated Hosts be lost since in each particle is present the entire Body of Christ. Therefore, one should take the greatest care that fragments do not easily separate from the Host and fall to the ground, where—horribile dictu! —they could become mixed with the garbage and be trampled underfoot.” (Instruction of the Sacred Congregation for the Discipline of the Sacraments 26 March 1929: AAS 21 (1920) 635.)

Redemptionis Sacramentum (2004) The Church's current universal norms:

[92.] ...special care should be taken to ensure that the host is consumed by the communicant in the presence of the minister, so that no one goes away carrying the Eucharistic species in his hand. **If there is a risk of profanation, then Holy Communion should not be given in the hand to the faithful.** [179] Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, Dubium: Notitiae 35 (1999) pp. 160-161.

[93.] The Communion-plate for the Communion of the faithful should be retained, so as to **avoid the danger of the sacred host or some fragment of it falling.** [180] Cf. Missale Romanum, Institutio Generalis, n. 118.

[94.] It is **not licit for the faithful “to take . . . by themselves . . . and, still less, to hand . . . from one to another” the sacred host** or the sacred chalice. Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, Dubium: Notitiae 35 (1999) pp. 160-161.

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244*

**AFTER* calling local law enforcement.*
