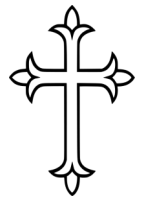


# Immaculate Conception Parish Saint Stanislaus Parish

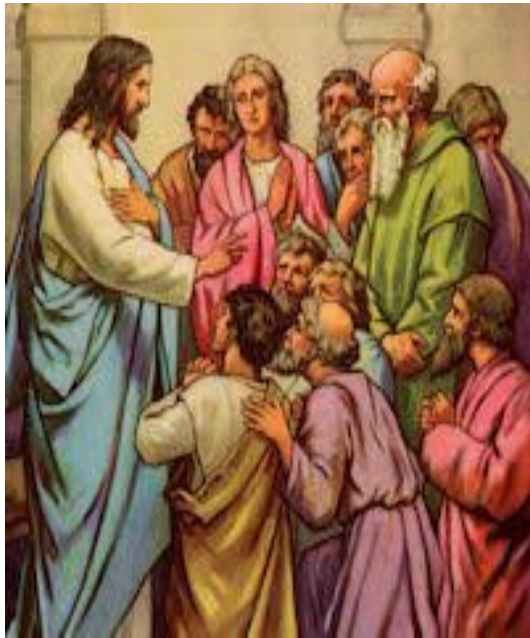


*The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread.*

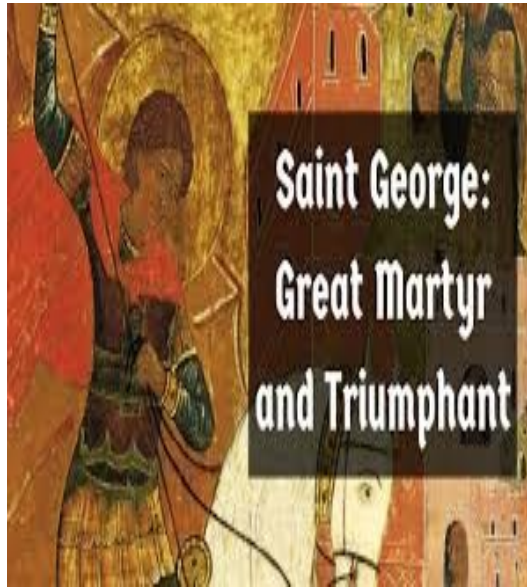
