

Pastor's Corner

Dear Family,

Rejoice! On this 3rd Sunday of Advent, we are invited to rejoice because Christmas is quickly approaching, and Christ is drawing near to us. **Gaudete Sunday** (pronounced: *Gow-day-tay*), offers us a glimpse of the joy ahead. It is often marked by the use of rose colored vestments as well as the lighting of the rose advent candle. In order to fully appreciate this joy-filled Sunday, it is helpful to reflect on the violet/purple color that marks the other Sundays of Advent as well as most of the Sundays of Lent. So, what's the connection? Violet is the color of penance and preparation. The Church states that in the seasons of Advent and Lent, music and decorations in the church should be moderate (less intense), even for weddings.

Gaudete Sunday has more of an impact for us if we have been moderating pleasures and celebration in our lives by focusing more on preparation and cleaning up our hearts for the great guest that is coming. This might look like focusing on an Advent resolution for prayer such as praying the rosary as a family each evening or charitable acts like buying a gift for the poor (Jesse tree gift tags). Ideally, it would mean not spending too much time on shopping or pre-Christmas partying. I know that's not always feasible as many extended family Christmas parties occur before Christmas, but if possible, it's better to have them during the Christmas season. Going to Confession is one of the best things you can do to live out the "purple Sundays". Taking time to read and discuss the Nativity Story (Luke 2:1-20) as a family, to meditate on Advent reflections (Adore by Fr. Josh Burns is excellent), or go Christmas Caroling are wonderful ways to keep Christ in Christmas. Truthfully, there's not much to celebrate on Gaudete Sunday if we haven't been drawing closer to Christ during the season specifically marked out to help us prepare. Rose means little if purple is ignored. There is no gain without some spiritual growth pains. Christ comes to us, but he is also waiting for us to come to Him. He stands at the door and knocks, but he won't bust the door down and come in uninvited.

Let's remember that Christmas isn't one day, but a whole season and lasts till the January 8th, which is the Feast of the Baptism of our Lord. There is even a special octave (8 days) that starts Christmas day and ends on January 1st. This octave is marked by the Church's encouragement for us to celebrate with all of our heart and energy. During this octave, we pray the Gloria at each Mass! This is the time to celebrate like never before. I want to invite you to come to weekday Mass from December 27th-29th and to adore Christ on these special days of Christmas. **Let's not lose sight of the reason for the season.**

One more thing. <u>Please don't take your Christmas lights down before January 8th!</u> We are Catholics and Christmas isn't over until then! For many others, Christmas is over and there's nothing to celebrate after December 25th, but that's only the case if we think that presents, food, and music are all there really is to the holiday. We actually have everything to live for and celebrate because once we have Christ, who was born on Christmas day, the party has just begun and will last for eternity.

REPORTING SUSPECTED ABUSE

If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the **Kansas Department for Children** and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330.

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the Victim Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244 *AFTER* calling local law enforcement.
