Pastor's Corner

Charity, Prudence, and the Morning Offering

I wanted to briefly comment on Bishop Strickland's removal as bishop of the Diocese of Tyler, Texas by Pope Francis although I have no desire to create a detailed legal case in Bishop Strickland's defense or against him for that matter. Charity demands assuming the best about someone and trying to see them in the best possible light. This would apply to Bishop Strickland and our Holy Father. Prudence also directs us to resist the urge to jump to conclusions and instead to patiently wait till all the facts are in. Unfortunately, a number of Catholic journalists, Youtubers, and other commentators have this nasty habit of automatically condemning Pope Francis' decisions and assuming he has malicious motives that seek to undermine the Catholic Church. For example, several highly regarded Catholic Youtubers made the claim that Bishop Strickland was basically removed overnight, with no due process, no warning, no explanation as to why he was being removed. This simply wasn't true as we later found out. There was another well-known and outspoken Catholic Priest who was removed from ministry not too long ago in another diocese. Many news outlets did the same thing, immediately declaring him innocent and Pope Francis and the priest's local bishop as wolves who were trying to destroy the "good priests". It turns out that this priest was highly imprudent, disobedient, and slanderous and had rightly been punished. I mainly wanted to point this out to caution you in regard to the media you consume. Use prudence, don't jump to conclusions, test the evidence, and don't assume the worst about Pope Francis. I'm not trying to defend all of his decisions in the least, but I don't like the attitude of constant suspicion people have toward him and the lack of charity shown toward him. It's simply unhealthy and divisive.

There was some talk recently about whether a transsexual can be baptized and/or act as a godparent at a baptism and I wanted to share the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith's response to a Brazilian Bishop's request for guidance in this matter. This has been translated from the Italian by one of our archdiocesan priests. I will only share a portion of it for the sake of space. "Can a transsexual be baptized? A transsexual - who has also undergone hormonal treatment and sex reassignment surgery can receive baptism, under the same conditions as other believers, if there are no situations in which there is a risk of generating public scandal or disorientation among the faithful. In the case of children or adolescents with problems of a transsexual nature, if well prepared and willing, they can receive Baptism."

The Dicastery's response also notes that a transsexual can serve as a godparent unless "there is a risk of scandal, undue legitimization, or disorientation in the educational sphere of the ecclesial community." So, it is left up to the pastor to use discretion and make decisions on a case-by-case basis. The Vatican is not promoting Transgender Ideology and makes it clear that there must be an intention to live a life in conformity with the Faith. I appreciate this answer as it allows priests the flexibility to make decisions that will help lead souls to Christ AND to avoid causing scandal or confusion among the faithful.

> Lastly, I wanted to remind everyone of my desire that we pray the morning offering (given to you in the form of a holy card) each day of Advent as a way to imitate Jesus, who became man for our sake, so that he could offer himself on our behalf. It is my hope that by making a daily morning offering this Advent, we will make this a habit for life and come to more fully offer our lives at each Mass in union with the perfect sacrifice of Jesus Christ to the Father. We have lots of extra holy cards with the morning offering, so be sure to pick some up and put one on your nightstand and in your car!

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured. If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless

of when the abuse occurred — call the <u>archdiocesan confidential report</u> <u>line</u> at (913) 647-3051 or the <u>Victim</u> <u>Care Advocate</u> at (913) 298-9244
