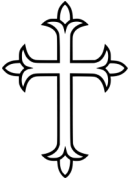

History of the White Mass

The tradition of the White Mass in the United States
finds its origins in the development of the national
Catholic Medical Association in the early 1930s. From
its inception, the medical profession has been under-
stood as a healing profession, a way in which Christ's
work continues upon the earth. Moreover, since the
apparitions at Lourdes in the late 19th century, the
plight of the infirmed- and those who care for them-
have taken on renewed appreciation in participating in
the mysteries of Christ's own life. The White Mass, so
named by the color worn by those in the healing profes-
sion of medicine, gathers health care professionals un-
der the patronage of St. Luke to ask God's blessing upon
the patient, doctor, nurse, and caregiver alike.

*If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the **Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center** by calling (800) 922-5330.*

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244*

**AFTER* calling local law enforcement.*
