## Mary's Purification; Presentation of Jesus, the Light for Salvation; and ... Groundhog Day?


In obedience to Mosaic Law, Mary, Mother of God, entered into the temple for Purification—40 days following the birth of her male Child, Jesus Christ. As it was custom for all mothers, she offered her newborn Son. This Presentation of Jesus Christ is the reflection upon which we meditate in the Fifth Joyful Mystery of the Holy Rosary. In the moment of seeing Our Lord, St. Simeon gave thanks to God for allowing him to finally behold the Messiah and refers to Jesus as, "a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." (Luke 2:32) It is Mary's humility coupled with Our Savior's humble birthplace and Incarnation as God, made-man, that illuminates the path for us to humbly seek and obey God's will in our own lives.

Following this great account of Christ being the Light for salvation, the custom of Candlemas began in the fourth century and the lighting /blessing of the candles began in the fifth century. The Feast of the Presentation (Candlemas) is always on February 2nd each year. Because of its beautiful significance, the Holy Father, Saint Pope John Paul II, instituted the custom of keeping the display of the Nativity scene in St. Peter's Square until February 2nd, marking it the closing of the Christmas season.

**FUN FACT:** Brought into American tradition by Christian German immigrants in the late 1800s, the first Groundhog Day was celebrated on Candlemas. Legend says, "If Candlemas Day is clear and bright, winter will have another bite. If Candlemas Day brings cloud and rain, winter is gone and will not come again."

This year, parishioners may bring candles from home or may pick-up one from church to have blessed for use in your homes. February 2nd lands on the First Friday this year. Therefore, there will be two Mass options: Daily Mass—6:15am at IC and Homeschool Mass—10am at St.

Stanislaus. All are welcome to attend either Mass.



If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330.

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the Victim Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244 \*AFTER\* calling local law enforcement.
