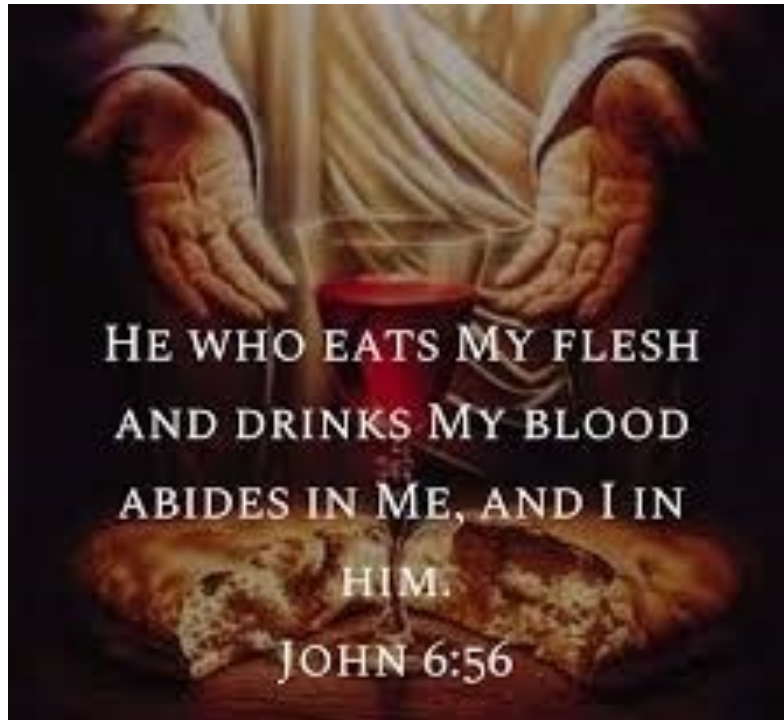
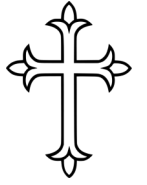

Pastor's Corner

Quick Facts:

-DOB May 18, '84 Jersey City, NJ: people are surprised when I tell them I'm closer to 50 than I am to 30!

-Ordained at Holy Spirit, Overland Park, KS in 2011 (June 18th)

-Previous assignments as Priest: Rome (11-13); Holy Trinity, Lenexa, KS (13-16), Kenrick Glennon Seminary (Spiritual Director), St Louis (16-20); St Agnes, Roeland Park, KS (20-21); St Michael the Archangel, Leawood, KS (21-24)

Unique facts:

-My parents, my older brother and I were baptized together when I was 3 yrs old.

-I have no nieces or nephews...but 10 godchildren (and counting)!

-This is my 10th move (and ninth DIFFERENT place I've lived) Jersey City, NJ; Los Angeles; Chicago; Champaign, IL; Lawrence, KS; Rome; Overland Park; St Louis). I say that I'm from Chicago but that I'm an adopted Kansan. I belong to the people of northeast Kansas and I'm here to stay!

-I did my STL (Licentiate degree in theology) dissertation on the sacrificial dimension of the Sacred Priesthood, according to Fulton J. Sheen.

- What's the most difficult task you've completed so far and why? Writing & completing my STL dissertation (2012-2016). It was agonizing! While I enjoy writing, it can be a painstaking process.

Name some special experiences you've had:

-I lived in Rome for eight years from 2005-2013 and I was present at St Peter's Square when Pope Francis was announced as the Vicar of Christ on earth.

-I did my 30 day silent retreat in 2017 (a grace comparable to the gift of the Sacred Priesthood).

-I served at KGS seminary for 4 years (2016-20) as a spiritual director in St Louis.

-I completed a 3 year spiritual director program through the IPF (Institute of Priestly Formation) (2017-20).

-I was a member of a religious community (Priests of the Apostles of the Interior Life) for 16 years (2005-21).

What do you look forward to most in this new assignment?

As in all my previous assignments:

1) To truly get to know the people of God, to journey together in the Faith toward the Triune God!

2) To receive instruction from you (I have so much to learn!) in how to pastor. It's akin to being a first time parent: so much to learn!

Thank you in advance for your patience in instructing me as I learn from you!

Support For Catholic Schools in the Holy Land—July 13/14th Second Collection

There are some forty-four Catholic schools in the Latin Patriarchate in the Holy Land that have extreme financial needs due to the ongoing unrest in the Holy Land and war in Gaza; some of them are in need of refurbishment, others have even more serious structural challenges. Our parish will take up a second collection on the weekend of July 13 & 14 to help the Latin Patriarchate restore and update the schools and pay its teachers' salaries. As a result of the war and the cancellation of work permits, there is severe unemployment. Many families are not able to pay their tuition, resulting in a budget deficit for teachers' salaries. The work of the Latin Patriarchate's education system is well-known and serves children and youth of all faiths. They can be seen as an oasis of collaboration, interreligious activity, and dialogue in a land where those opportunities are most needed and often sadly lacking. The funds collected will be transferred to the Order of the Holy Sepulchre for distribution to the Latin Patriarchate for the schools. Thank you for your generous support.

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244*
