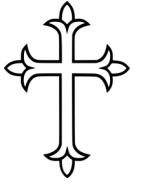

Pastor's Corner

Dear Family in Christ,

In due time, I'll share about myself, in person, and through this venue in the coming months.

After prayer, I was inspired to dedicate my first week's topic in honor of our beloved former pastor, Father Justin!

Due to his extraordinary generosity, I had the blessing of spending eight hours with Father on June 12th - an orientation day for me! Eight... hours!

I cannot emphasize the exceptional nature of Father's gesture - given the circumstances, it's not reasonable to expect more than an hour or two. I felt a deep sense of gratitude during my time with Father, as he so generously and attentively explained and answered my inquiries.

On my 90 minute drive back to St. Michael's parish - I was moved to tears in prayer with profound gratitude and so edified by his priestly example of knowing his flock and laying his life down for it.

His wisdom, humility, attentiveness, balanced pastoral approach, and the evident habit of pouring himself out in sacrificial love for you all are... uncommon. I've interacted with and come to know many priests during my eight years in Rome, as well as many priests from around the country in the last two decades. Father Justin is of the highest caliber in how he lives pastoral charity according to the Heart of Christ the Priest.

I will state what you already know: You have been so blessed with a pastor after Christ's own Shepherd Heart in these last four years!

After eight hours with Father, I can confidently attest that we are very much aligned, theologically (doctrinally and morally), philosophically in our pastoral care, and liturgically.

In light of this, I invite you to continue the grieving process WITH THE LORD in prayer. Be attentive and honest with the Lord and take time to grieve the pain of loss. Please, do not ignore it. Grieving is a necessary and healthy process. Transition is not easy - whether it's for Father Justin, for me, or for you all. Pain, in this instance, reveals the Love of God we've experienced in our depths. We call this "the pain of loss."

The Lord gives you permission to grieve over the coming months and year as you adapt to a new shepherd who will strive to get to know you personally and love you as faithfully as possible, according to Christ's own Heart.

Second invitation: Let's thank the Lord - for Father's four years as your shepherd. Ask the Lord directly, in prayer, to reveal the specific blessings you've received from the Lord, mediated by Father Justin's ministry. Thank God, directly.

"Most Loving Trinity, I thank you for Father Justin and for (name the blessing)."

Do not stop praying for Father: Let's continue to unite ourselves in prayer and in sacrifice for him and for his intentions!

Support For Catholic Schools in the
Holy Land—July 13/14th Second Collection

There are some forty-four Catholic schools in the Latin Patriarchate in the Holy Land that have extreme financial needs due to the ongoing unrest in the Holy Land and war in Gaza; some of them are in need of refurbishment, others have even more serious structural challenges. Our parish will take up a second collection on the weekend of July 13 & 14 to help the Latin Patriarchate restore and update the schools and pay its teachers' salaries. As a result of the war and the cancellation of work permits, there is severe unemployment. Many families are not able to pay their tuition, resulting in a budget deficit for teachers' salaries. The work of the Latin Patriarchate's education system is well-known and serves children and youth of all faiths. They can be seen as an oasis of collaboration, interreligious activity, and dialogue in a land where those opportunities are most needed and often sadly lacking. The funds collected will be transferred to the Order of the Holy Sepulchre for distribution to the Latin Patriarchate for the schools. Thank you for your generous support.

*If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the **Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center** by calling (800) 922-5330.*

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244*

**AFTER* calling local law enforcement.*
