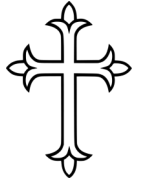

Pastor's Corner

Magnificent Magnificat

Have you ever heard of the Catholic publication called *Magnificat*? Let me share a short description of it taken directly from their website: <https://bookstore.magnificat.net/>

MAGNIFICAT is a spiritual guide to help you develop your prayer life, grow in your spiritual life, find a way to a more profound love for Christ, and participate in the holy Mass with greater fervor.

MAGNIFICAT is a monthly publication designed for daily use, to encourage both liturgical and personal prayer. It can be used to follow daily Mass and can also be read at home or wherever you find yourself for personal or family prayer.

Every day, in a convenient, pocket-sized format, MAGNIFICAT offers beautiful prayers for both morning and evening drawn from the treasures of the Liturgy of the Hours, the official texts of daily Mass, meditations written by spiritual giants of the Church and more contemporary authors, essays on the lives of the saints of today and yesterday, and articles giving valuable spiritual insight into masterpieces of sacred art.

I have subscribed to *Magnificat* for the last several years and at the affordable price of \$49 a year (12 issues), I've found it to be an invaluable resource in my spiritual life. What I like best about it is how it provides the daily Scripture readings for Mass so that even if you don't attend Mass on a weekday, you still have a bite-sized portion of Scripture to read and meditate on each day, which is a lot less intimidating and overwhelming than simply opening your Bible at random and wondering how much you should read that day. In other words, it facilitates a life-changing habit of reading a little Scripture each day and doing so in a way that is orderly and united to the rest of the Church and Liturgical Year. I also really like the little one page "Saint Who" write-ups which help me become more familiar with the lives of the saints.

I am heartily recommending this publication because it is an excellent way to begin praying as a family each morning or evening. There is a short, but powerful set of prayers, Scripture readings, and intercessions for each morning and evening all laid out in a simple and organized format. You know what that means? You can feel confident as a spiritual leader in your family without any planning! Best of all, it takes away any excuses such as "I don't know how to lead my family in prayer" or "it takes too long and the kids go crazy".

Magnificat makes a great gift. Order it for yourself or someone you love! Because it's so easy to use and portable (you even get online access via their app), you can use it during your lunch hour. It is a chance to make a real difference in the life of someone (perhaps yourself) and serves as a physical reminder that God is calling us to spend time with Him in prayer.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244 ****AFTER**** calling local law enforcement.*
