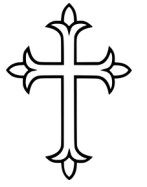

Pastor's Corner

Dear Family,

Well, this is my last *Pastor's Corner*. The good news is that you will probably no longer have to read size 10 font text anymore. The pastor's corner became "the pastor's page" over the last few years!

You have been such a blessing to me and I find myself thanking God for you again and again as I prepare to move. A prayer, similar to the suscipe prayer of St. Ignatius of Loyola, comes to my mind when my heart grows sad at the thought of leaving you:

You have given them all to me; to you, Lord, I return them. Thank you for allowing me to be their spiritual father. Give me only your Love and your Grace. That is enough for me.

I have two final exhortations for you; one is to **unity**, the other to **perseverance**. If you strive to live these out, you will bring joy to my heart and will have honored me greatly.

"Now I appeal to you, brothers and sisters,^[a] by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you be in agreement and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same purpose" (1 Cor 1:10).

How much I have learned in the last four years about the importance of unity! Before I received this assignment, I did not place nearly a high enough priority on unity in my actions and attitudes. As Christ said, a house divided cannot stand. I beg you to avoid anything which will cause division in our church or community. Be of one heart and mind with your new pastor, Fr. Ahn, with our Archbishop and Holy Father, and with each other. Of course, we will always have disagreements, but they must never be rooted in pride and must always be accompanied by charity.

Regarding perseverance, remember that Christ said, "the one who perseveres to the end will be saved" (Mt 24:13). Don't stop going to Mass and Confession! Don't let go of your visits to the Blessed Sacrament. Pray the rosary often. The priest must be the bridge to Christ, but never become the destination himself. I pray that I've led you to Christ and not just to myself. If you persevere in the practice of your faith when I'm gone, I will have succeeded in leading you to Christ.

**Support For Catholic Schools in the
Holy Land---July 13/14th Second Collection**

There are some forty-four Catholic schools in the Latin Patriarchate in the Holy Land that have extreme financial needs due to the ongoing unrest in the Holy Land and war in Gaza; some of them are in need of refurbishment, others have even more serious structural challenges. Our parish will take up a second collection on the weekend of July 13 & 14 to help the Latin Patriarchate restore and update the schools and pay its teachers' salaries. As a result of the war and the cancellation of work permits, there is severe unemployment. Many families are not able to pay their tuition, resulting in a budget deficit for teachers' salaries. The work of the Latin Patriarchate's education system is well-known and serves children and youth of all faiths. They can be seen as an oasis of collaboration, interreligious activity, and dialogue in a land where those opportunities are most needed and often sadly lacking. The funds collected will be transferred to the Order of the Holy Sepulchre for distribution to the Latin Patriarchate for the schools. Thank you for your generous support.

REPORTING SUSPECTED ABUSE

*If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the **Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center** by calling (800) 922-5330.*

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244. *AFTER* calling local law enforcement.*
