Pastor's Corner

Walking the Via Dolorosa of Holy Week

Each year, Holy Mother Church invites us to spiritually walk the Via Dolorosa (Sorrowful Way), which is the traditional route in Jerusalem which Our Lord traveled on the day of His crucifixion from the judgment seat of Pontius Pilate to the place of His crucifixion on Mount Calvary. While most likely we can't physically go to Jerusalem to walk the Via Dolorosa, we can still use Holy Week as a time to reflect more deeply on the most sacred mysteries of our Faith, namely, the Paschal Mystery: the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. How important is the Paschal Mystery?

> "Christ redeemed us all and gave perfect glory to God principally through his paschal mystery: dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life. Therefore, the Easter triduum of the passion and resurrection of Christ is the culmination of the entire liturgical year. Thus the solemnity of Easter has the same kind of preeminence in the liturgical year that Sunday has in the week." (General Norms for the Liturgical Year and the Calendar, #18)

Jesus taught us to pray "Hallowed be Thy Name" in the Lord's Prayer. God's name is already perfectly Holy, so we can't make it any holier, but we can strive to better reflect God's holiness in the way we live our lives as Christians. In a similar way, Holy Week is already holy because it's focused on the Paschal Mystery. However, we can "hallow this holy week" by our intentional participation in it.

Here are a few ways we can make Holy Week more fruitful:

- 1. Attend the Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper and the Good Friday Liturgy in addition to an Easter Mass of the Resurrection. Please make this a priority!
- 2. Cancel any unnecessary activities, projects, etc. on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and Easter Sunday. Less noise = more time to meditate.
- 3. Pray the Stations of the Cross. There will be "Stations of the Cross" reflection booklets at the back of church so you can drop in when the church is open and pray them on your own this week.
- 4. Make it a rule for your family that the TV stays off from 7pm on Holy Thursday through Good Friday. Perhaps it could also be a family rule to abstain from all social media and video games during this time as well.
- 5. Watch the *Passion of the Christ* movie produced by Mel Gibson.



Will we stay on the outside, robotically and minimally observing Holy Week, or will we walk through the door , and allow the liturgies of this week to transform us?

If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330. Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured. If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the <u>Victim</u> Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244
