

Pastor's Corner



CHRIST IS RISEN! ALLELUIA!



A happy and blessed Easter to you and your family! Today is the pinnacle of the whole year for the Christian soldier, a day of pure light and joy, a day in which we celebrate in mystery the triumph of Jesus Christ over sin and death, by his rising from the dead. In an Easter homily, Saint Melito of Sardis describes this wonderful victory:

"He is the One who covered death with shame and cast the devil into mourning, as Moses cast Pharaoh into mourning. He is the One who smote sin and robbed iniquity of offspring. He is the One who brought us out of darkness into light, out of death into life, out of tyranny into an eternal kingdom."

For us Christians, everything hinges on the Resurrection. As St. Paul said, "if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain" (1 Cor 15:14). The tomb is empty, the sun has risen, and Jesus Christ is alive! Our faith is not in vain.

I want to extend a special welcome to all of you who have been away from Church for a while. It is so good to have you with us. Our parish family is not the same without you; we are not as strong without you and there are empty seats at the table, which is a tragedy for any family.

Our celebration of the Paschal Mystery (the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ for our salvation) is not something we merely commemorate as some long past event that we recall with sentimental fondness. Rather, it is a mystery that we celebrate as being present right here, right now, powerful, alive, and transformative in our own lives. Christ has already risen, once and for all, some 2000 years ago. What He most desires is that each of us share in the power of His Resurrection here in this Easter Season. After today, will we go back to our old way of life, back to the tomb, back to a life apart from Christ? Or will we allow these Sacred Liturgies to become a way of life for us, a resurrection to a new life, one involving a daily renunciation of sin in our lives, and a life centered on Christ in Sunday Mass, regular Confession, and daily prayer?

Mary's Choices helps many mothers and babies through our Earn While You Learn program that provides educational videos, companionship, and material support to mothers who have chosen life. Mothers may participate in our program through pregnancy and until their baby is two years old. Last year (2023), 110 mothers and 131 babies actively participated in our program, watching parenting education videos and receiving baby supplies every 2 months.

In 2023, Mary's Choices provided \$73,000 in baby supplies which included 1,928 packs of diapers, 910 packs of baby wipes, 2,750 baby outfits, 1,265 hygiene products, and 367 new books. Please share our information with any mothers who may need our

REPORTING SUSPECTED ABUSE

If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330.

Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured.

If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the Victim Care Advocate at (913) 298-9244 *AFTER* calling local law enforcement.
