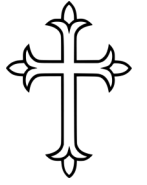

Pastor's Corner

Dear Parish Family-

Every year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of Mary on December 8th. Though typically a holy day of obligation, this year the Solemnity is transferred to Monday, December 9th, and is NOT a holy day of obligation.

For this occasion, I'm wholeheartedly inviting you to **prayerfully consider** joining other parishioners in a "**Consecration to Jesus through Mary**", whether for the very first time, or renewing a previously made consecration.

What is Consecration to Jesus through Mary?

In short, it is a renewal of our commitment at Sacred Baptism: to belong entirely to God – loving surrender of my will and entire self. It is a willful, loving submission of my entire self to Jesus, through Mary.

Why Consecration to Jesus through Mary?

Why through Mary? Because the first time the Holy Spirit brought Jesus into the world, He willed to do so in union with Mary.

-The Holy Spirit and Mary formed Jesus in her womb.

-The Holy Spirit and Mary **ardently desire to form Jesus in you and me.**

What would I concretely be committing to over 33 days?

1) From November 5th through December 8th: pray the following prayer daily (you will receive a laminated card)

"Totally yours, Immaculate Conception, Mary my Mother, Live in me, Act in me, Speak in me and through me, Think your thoughts in my mind, Love through my heart, Give me your dispositions and feelings, Teach, lead me and guide me to Jesus, Correct, enlighten and expand my thoughts and behavior, Possess my soul, Take over my entire personality and life, replace it with Yourself, Incline me to constant adoration, Pray in me and through me, Let me live in you and keep me in this union always."

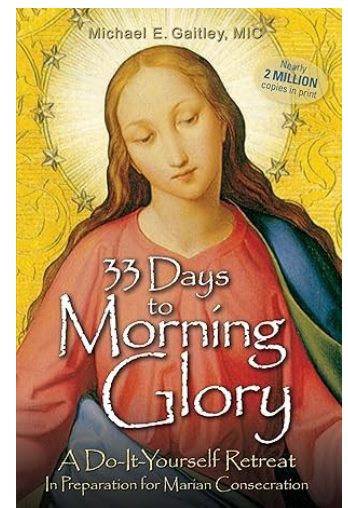
2) Offer some sacrifice or penance daily during these 33 days as a reminder of this daily process of Consecration.

If you desire to do a more intensive Consecration to Jesus through Mary, you are free to do so (for example, through St Louis de Montfort or as proposed by Father Michael Gaitley)

At the end of each weekend Mass (beginning November 9th through December 8th), we will recite the Consecration prayer.

*If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the **archdiocesan confidential report line** at (913) 647-3051 or the **Victim Care Advocate** at (913) 298-9244*
